Low back pain

History of Present Illness (location, quality, severity, timing, setting, alleviating/ aggravating factors, associated signs and symptoms)

Patient reports low back pain for the past 6 months. Pain is located in the lower back, with a dull ache quality, and moderate intensity. Pain is exacerbated with prolonged sitting and standing, and relieved with rest. No associated signs or symptoms.

Past Medical History (allergies, current medication, injuries, hospitalizations, surgeries)

No allergies reported. Current medication includes ibuprofen as needed. No history of injuries, hospitalizations or surgeries.

Assessment

General Observations

Patient is diagnosed with low back pain, likely due to prolonged standing and heavy lifting at work. Patient has moderate pain intensity with associated activity limitations.

Plan

Treatment Plan

Patient will undergo a course of physical therapy including stretching and strengthening exercises to improve lumbar flexibility and stability. Modalities such as heat and electrical stimulation may also be used. Patient will be educated on proper body mechanics to reduce strain on the lower back during work activities. Patient will be advised to avoid activities that aggravate the pain and to continue taking ibuprofen as needed for pain management. Patient will follow up with the therapist in 2 weeks for re-evaluation.

Patient is motivated to participate in therapy and shows good compliance with home exercise program.

General Observations

Patient demonstrates a mild decrease in lumbar flexibility with a positive straight leg raise test. No signs of neurological deficits.
