Describe what happened. Please be detailed but state only facts.

On the afternoon of September 22, 2023, at approximately 12:30 PM, a critical incident occurred involving one of our electrical system workers, Mr. John Turner, while he was performing routine maintenance on an electrical panel at a commercial client's premises.

The incident took place at Industrial Avenue, Los Angeles, CA during a scheduled maintenance visit. Mr. Turner was assigned to inspect and troubleshoot an electrical panel supplying power to various machinery in the client's manufacturing facility. While conducting his work, Mr. Turner identified a potential issue with one of the circuit breakers that required immediate attention.

Upon opening the electrical panel and attempting to perform a visual inspection, Mr. Turner inadvertently made contact with a live wire due to inadequate labeling and a lack of clear identification of the circuit breaker in question. This resulted in an electrical shock, causing Mr. Turner to sustain injuries.
